WHO WE ARE

The Professional Tennis Players Association is an organization created **BY** the players **FOR** the players. We are the leading advocate for professional tennis players worldwide and we serve to support, protect and advance players' wellbeing on and off the court. We aim to maximize the power of the collective and united player body to ensure fair representation and consideration. We work on behalf of the best interests of all players and players alone and do not answer to any other stakeholders.

WHAT WE AIM TO DO

- Provide help, protection and support for grievances and other issues players face during their life on tour
- Keep players informed and educated about tour and tennis-related decisions affecting their careers, ensuring their concerns are heard and voices represented
- Generate additional revenue through Group Licensing Agreements (GLAs) through the PTPA's for-profit affiliate Winners Alliance
- Advocate for players with the Tours, Grand Slams, and other governing bodies such as ITIA and WADA
- Push for higher revenue shares, larger and equal prize money, improved structure such as calendar and match scheduling, transparency and more opportunities
- Offer players access to a wide range of PTPA services, benefits and resources, including, but not limited to, discounts and rebates from major brands, continuing education and post career opportunities, financial planning, legal and mental health services, and much more
- Evolve and adapt to address the challenges players face in the ever-changing world of tennis

WHY JOIN

Because tennis is an individual sport, it is crucial for the players to be able to unite and use their combined strength and collective power to protect their rights and make a lasting impact on the industry and their daily lives. The PTPA ensures that the perspectives of all players are heard and considered, creating a unified front to address key issues. As part of the PTPA, players will not only receive information and education about the intricacies of the tennis world, but they will also have the chance to contribute to the decision-making process that directly affects their careers and livelihoods.

WHAT TO KNOW

Players are represented by the Executive Committee (EC), which consists of 4 WTA and 4 ATP players. The EC serves and acts as a voice for all players (ATP & WTA) in all decision making processes. PTPA members will participate in December 2023 elections, casting one vote for a representative. Men's players vote for a male representative, while women's players vote for a women's representative. The top vote recipients from both will form the Executive Committee for that year.
